This is a Portsmouth & Double Portsmouth with UK Record Status hosted by Derwent Bowmen on behalf of Derbyshire County Archery Association. Archers from other counties are welcome. The layout for the event is 6 sessions spread over 2 days. We can accommodate up to 24 archers shooting in each session. The session times on both days will be 9am, 12 noon and 3pm. For the Double Portsmouth, both sessions must be on the same day. There will be an Awards ceremony at the end of shooting on the Sunday.

We will hold a raffle prior to the Awards ceremony. Donations from Derbyshire County clubs are welcome.

Refreshments will be available throughout the day.

4. Only archers affiliated through DCAA are eligible to receive any county trophies.
5. Holders of Trophies are requested to return them at or before the tournament
6. If you wish to take photographs during the competition please register at reception. Flashes are not to be used.
7. Tournament results will be sent by email and published online, including on the county website.
8. Senior competitors shooting Compound will be on a 3 spot face.

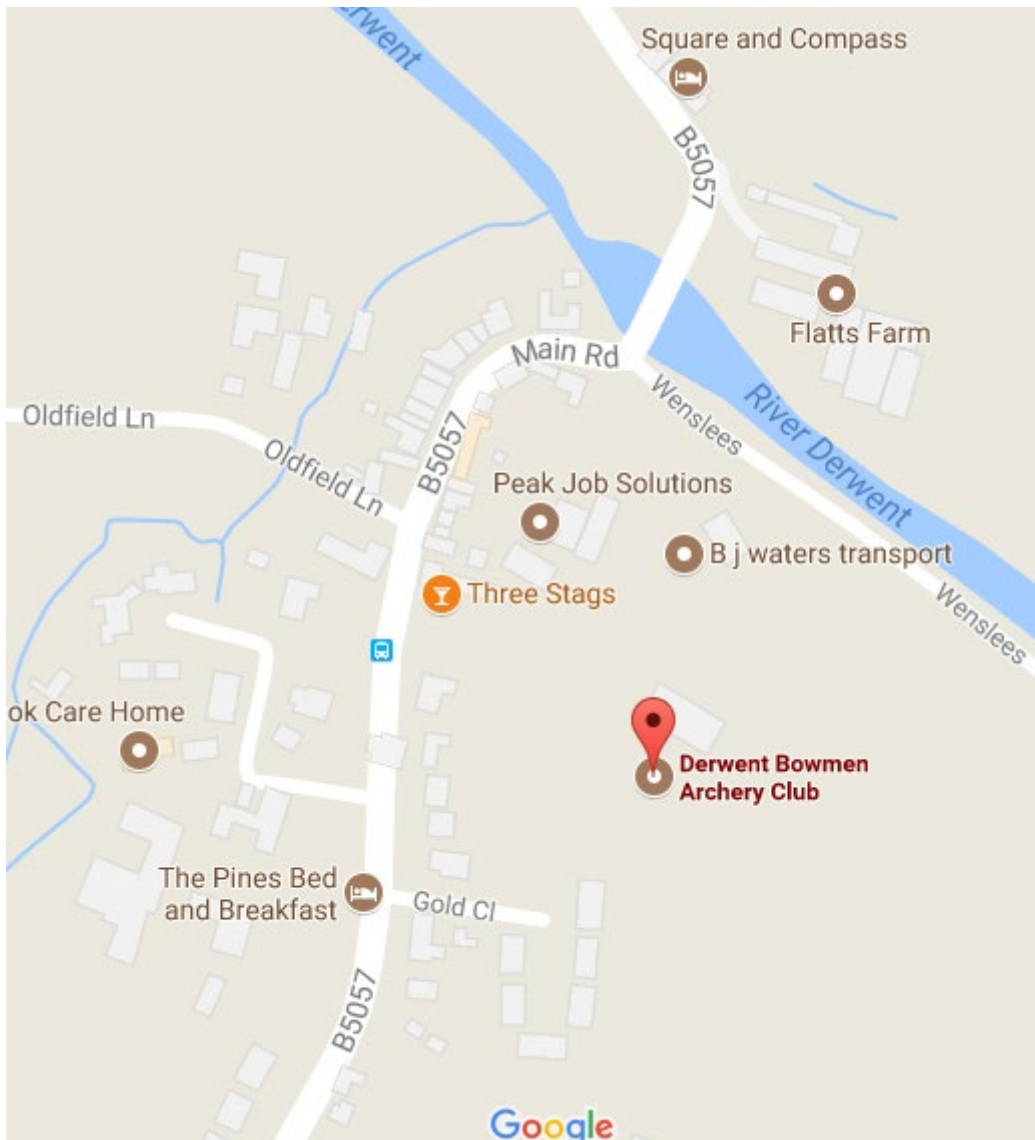

Directions from A6

After leaving the A6 onto Station Road, the B5057 to Winster, with Barringtons Hotel (formerly the Whitworth Hotel) and Whitworth Park on your right. Past over the Peak Rail railway line, pass the Fourways cross roads, then Darley Dale Cricket Club on your right. The road narrows as you pass the Square & Compass pub on your left. You cross the River Derwent and the road winds round to your right then left through the village of Darley Bridge. After you pass the 3 Stags Heads pub on your left Gold Close is about 100 yards further up the road on your left.
