Registration: Registration will be open from 8:00am. Membership cards <u>will</u> be required for booking in. If you are not in possession of a 2023/24 card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.

Event Timings: Assembly 8:45am, followed by 2 ends of **practice**. The round will commence immediately after practice. Equipment inspections will take place during registration and before practice.

Event Format: WA Double 720 round to be shot in accordance with World Archery Rules of Shooting. There will be four archers per target. Recurve & Longbow will be shooting at 70m on a 122cm target face, with Compound & Barebow at 50m, on individual 80cm reduced size faces and 122cm faces respectively.

Metric 122-50, 122-40 & 122-30 will be shot according to AGB rules of shooting. There will be four archers per target.

Spaces for Archers opting for the single round will be subject to entries. Priority will be given to those shooting the double round.

Archers opting for the single round only will only be eligible for the handicap award.

Archers shooting the single rounds will be entered in the morning session only.

Archers opting to shoot a shorter distance than their age group will only be eligible for the handicap award.

Scoring: Method 2 will be in place, six arrows timed at 4 minutes per end with 10 zone scoring in place.

Drug Testing: Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, with non-compliance being treated as a positive sample. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for junior (under 18) archers to be drug tested if approached.

<u>Photography:</u> Parents/Guardians are reminded that 'duty of care' for under 18s remains with them throughout the shoot. People wishing to take photographs during the tournament <u>must</u> register their details with the tournament organiser.
