We regret to inform you that LNER Archers has closed, as of 1 April 2024.

Unfortunately, our numbers have dwindled each year and with the restrictions placed on us by the Rifle and Pistol Club committee we were unable to obtain new members as they did not allow us to provide beginners courses or, more recently, to have any online presence. The increased LNER club subscription fees made it impossible for quite a few members to continue at renewal and it has meant that the archery club has become unviable.

Our member, Sandra Bennett was a County Judge, Regional Judge and also Treasurer of DCAA.

Our member, Yvonne Long was County Secretary for 7 years.

Over the years a number of our members have shot for Club, County and Region and have held County Records, some that still stand today.

The small group of archers that are left have now joined Derwent Bowmen Archery Club and we look forward to meeting old friends and making new ones.
